1. The quantum of maintenance determined by the court below during the pendency of matrimonial proceedings is the subject of revision. The husband-petitioner is a petroleum product dealer of IOC and he has been directed to pay ₹20,000/- as maintenance for the wife and a child.

2. The husband has a grievance that he has a widowed mother to take care and he has already provided for the tuition fee for the child and housing needs of his wife. According to him, the amount assessed by the court is too high considering the financial needs of the respondent and income of the petitioner brought through the IT returns.

3. I am loathe to making an intervention for reducing the amount of maintenance granted against a person who is a dealer in petroleum products and ₹20,000/- cannot be said to be a much amount for him to cope with. The revision petition is dismissed.
