DR. BHARAT BHUSHAN PARSOON, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the petition with liberty to take all pleas taken here before the Court below, but urges that the interim order granted vide order dated 17.05.2013 may be allowed to continue and further urges that the main suit bearing No.804 of 2009 titled as Shallu Sharma Vs. Sidharth Sharma, should be decided by the Court below within some stipulated time.

Counsel for the respondents have no objection and states that they would also cooperate in early decision of the suit.

The trial Court is directed to decide the suit within six months.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

Interim order dated 17.05.2015 shall continue till disposal of the suit.

At this stage, counsel for the respondents states that another suit filed by the landlord titled as “Ashok Bhasin Vs. Sidharth Sharma” bearing Civil Suit No.154 of 2009 which is pending for adjudication, should also be decided expeditiously and preferably within six months.

Ordered accordingly.
