Counsel for the petitioners states that since respondents No.3 to 5 have already been proceeded against ex-parte before the lower court, they are not required for adjudication of this petition and their names may be struck off from the array of respondents. It is so done.

As per report of Registry, respondent No.2 is served through power of attorney but there is no representation on his behalf despite the case being called several times, he is, thus, proceeded against ex-parte.

Service is complete.

Counsel for the petitioners seeks withdrawal of this petition with liberty to take all the pleas, as have been raised in this petition, before the lower court at an appropriate stage but urges that some time limit should be fixed for adjudication of the civil suit pending before the lower court and further urges that nothing stated in the impugned orders may stand in the way of the petitioners at the time of adjudication of substantive rights of the parties to the suit before the lower court.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty. However, the lower court would decide the suit within six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, even by conducting day to day proceedings, if so required. It is made clear that any observations made in the impugned orders would not stand in the way of the petitioners at the time of adjudication of substantive rights of the parties to the suit before the lower court.
