The defendant who had remained ex-parte is faced with an attachment action for recovery of the decree that is passed in favour of the plaintiff. The defendant appears to have filed an application to set aside the ex-parte decree and has also applied to the trial Court for stay further proceedings. The counsel states that the stay application has not been disposed off. I direct the trial Court to pass an order on the stay application filed by the defendant within a period of 6 weeks from today. The Executing Court will not pass any precipitate order till the disposal of the application.

The civil revision petition is disposed of with the observations above, dispensing with notice to the respondent.
