Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 3.8.2000, passed by the learned court below, vide which the appeal filed by the petitioner against the order of the Collector requiring the petitioner to pay additional stamp duty of ₹ 6,600/-, was dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner sought to challenge the order while placing reliance upon the judgments of Hon'ble the Supreme Court in State of Punjab v. Mahabir Singh etc. etc., AIR 1996 SC 2994, of this Court in Chamkaur Singh and another v. State of Punjab and another, 1991 PLJ 249; Gauri Singla v. State of Haryana and others, 2008 (4) PLR 524 and Bombay High Court in Oriental Insurance Co. Ltd. v. State of Maharashtra, AIR 2007(3) Bom. R 536.

However, considering the fact that the amount involved in the present petition is merely ₹ 6,600/-, this court would not like to interfere in

the present petition. The same is, accordingly, dismissed.
