Impugned in the present revision is the order dated 20.12.2014 passed by the Additional District Judge, Bhiwani, affirming that of learned Civil Judge, Junior Division, Bhiwani, vide which an application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 read with Section 151 CPC granting interim injunction filed by the plaintiffs-respondents was dismissed.

Both the Courts below have given reasoning in support of the order. Therefore, exercising revisional powers there is nothing to show that the lower Court as well as the first appellate Court have failed to exercise the jurisdiction or has exercised the jurisdiction illegally. Nor there is anything to show that the order is perverted.

Consequently, the revision stands dismissed.
