Counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of this petition with liberty to take all the pleas, as have been raised in this petition, before the lower court at an appropriate stage. It is urged that the document of transfer on the basis of which application under Order I Rule 10 CPC of respondent No.3 has been allowed, in fact, does not confer any right, title or interest on applicant Rahul, who has now been impleaded as a defendant vide impugned order of 22.1.2014.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty. It is also made clear that relevance, admissibility, probative value as also validity and legality of the document on the basis of which applicant Rahul has been made a party in the suit would be determined by the court below and the plaintiff, petitioner herein, would be having liberty to impugn the validity and legality of the document of transfer itself.
