In reference to the decision rendered by this Court in **Civil Revision No.3290 of 2014**, titled "Ajay Partap Singh vs. Gurdial Singh and others", decided on 13.05.2015, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be permitted to withdraw the revision petition, so as to enable the petitioner to file an appeal before the Appellate Authority against the order that has been assailed.

It is submitted that as 15 days' time was granted to the petitioner by this Court in the aforesaid matter, to file an appeal, the petitioner too shall be given two weeks' time to avail the remedy by way of an appeal.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with a liberty to file an appeal within a period of two weeks from today.
