Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that petitioner Shanti Devi had since passed away and the demised premises has already been sold by her heirs. So much so, the respondent-tenant has even vacated the premises and restored its possession to successor owner. That being so, it is submitted that petition be disposed of as having become infructuous. However, if any dispute, cause of action or interest still survive, legal heirs of the petitioner shall have a liberty to move appropriate application for its restoration and decision of merits.

Ordered, accordingly.
