K.Kannan, J.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the decision rendered by the Civil Court may not be competent in view of the fact that the character of property as Wakf is denied by the defendant and consequently the case could be agitated only before the Wakf Tribunal. The revision is against the order passed by the trial Court and Appellate Court in its civil jurisdiction. The revision is disposed of with the direction that the trial Court will transfer the file to the Wakf Tribunal for disposal in accordance with law. The revision petition is, therefore, dismissed upholding the direction given by the Appellate Court that the plaint shall be returned and the plaintiff will have the liberty to approach the Wakf Tribunal for adjudication.
