Though it is not understood as to how issuance of direction to a Court below would be covered by filing a civil revision but irrespective of that, in view of the fact that the injunction application is pending since 16.12.2014 and the matter is already fixed before the trial Court on 10.7.2015 for evidence of the plaintiff, it is felt that the injunction application should be decided by an early date. The petition is, therefore, disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to decide the application for temporary injunction filed by the petitioner and for that, the trial Court shall hear the arguments on the application on the date already fixed, i.e. 10.7.2015 and pass an order thereafter within three days.
