AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from petitioner-Lekh Raj, states that the petitioner will not object to the sale of the property which has been mortgaged with the respondents for which the execution is pending. He further states that in case the sale proceeds, in the opinion of the Executing Court, are not enough to satisfy the decree, he would forthwith deposit the remaining amount.

The present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the trial Court by filing an application and give a statement, as aforesaid, supporting the same with an affidavit and an undertaking in Court as recorded above, within a period of three days from today and on doing so, his arrest shall remain stayed.
