Counsel for both the parties agree that judgment in ***Gurpreet Singh Versus Union of India 2008(2) RCR (Civil) 208 (Supreme Court)*** is applicable but counsel for the petitioners states that the parameters laid down therein have not been adhered to in letter and spirit causing total disarray in calculations.

Counsel for the petitioners has no objection if the case is decided in terms of ***Gurpreet Singh's case (supra)***.

In view of this position, the matter is remanded to the court below to decide the same afresh after hearing both the parties and after

getting the calculations from them. The court below would decide the matter in terms of ***Gurpreet Singh's case (supra)*** within one month from the date of passing of certified copy of this order, even by conducting day to day proceedings, if so required.

Parties are directed to appear before the court below on 6.6.2015.
