K.Kannan, J.

The landlord is NRI and he being a citizen of foreign country cannot maintain the status as NRI. Assailing as there is no order from Hon'ble Supreme Court against the order being adjudged, this cannot create a fetter for me to adjudge on this issue.

I have held in the judgment CR No. 2217 of 2015, M/s Blue Sky Worldwide Travels and another Vs. Harvinder Singh, decided on 01.04.2015, that the issue of NRI status cannot depend on whether the person is a citizen of India or not. There is no point for an argument and the Court was justified in declining the leave to defend.

The revision petition is dismissed.
