Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 25.04.2012, whereby application filed under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 read with Section 151 CPC has been allowed and appeal filed against the same, by the petitioners-defendants, has been dismissed on 15.06.2012. The orders have been passed as wayback as on 25.04.2012 and on 15.06.2012. It has been brought to the notice of this Court that suit is slated for the evidence of the plaintiffs.

Mr. R.S. Bains, learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioners submits, that under the garb of the interim order, respondents-plaintiffs are adopting all possible dilatory tactics, much less, no witness has been examined in support of their evidence. This fact has been denied by Mr. Arun Jain, learned Senior Counsel for the respondents. Be that as it may. But the fact remains that revision petition has arisen against the passing of the interim order passed in 2012.

I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present revision petition with direction to the trial Court to decide the suit as expeditiously as possible within a period of eight months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

The trial Court shall ensure that none of the parties to the lis adopts dilatory tactics and in case it is so, then trial Court can pass the order in accordance with law.

With the aforementioned direction, the present revision petition is disposed of.
