There is no justification for the petitioner/defendant to arrive before this court to complain that the opportunity was not given to him to cross-examine the plaintiff's witnesses and he should be granted an opportunity to cross-examine the plaintiff's witnesses. The defendant must approach the trial Court itself for such an opportunity and it is unnecessary for the petitioner to approach this court and vex the proceedings. The procedure has been laid down by this court in **Santosh Kumar Berry Versus Nirmala Devi and others-2013(1) PLR 404** and the petitioner will apprise himself about the march of law and proceed in accordance with law.

2. The civil revision is dismissed but with the above observations.
