This revision petition is against the order dismissing an application for condonation of delay of 103 days in preferring the appeal. Respondent has been served but there is no appearance to contest the application.

The order already passed is set aside on the condition that the petitioner deposits Rs. 5,000/- as costs, payable to the respondent when he served with notice to claim the same. The amount shall be deposited to the credit of case before the Appellate Court, within a period of four weeks from the date of the receipt of the copy of the order. The amount, if not paid, as directed, the order already passed stands restored. If the amount is deposited, the Court will issue notice in appeal to the respondents.

The civil revision petition is allowed on the above terms.
