Petitioner has filed this petition challenging the award dated 10.11.2000 and consequential proceedings.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the arbitration award has been passed in the absence of the petitioner and the present petition has been filed by the petitioner before this Court because the application under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 ('Act' for short) had been rendered time barred.

In the present case, award (Annexure P-1) was passed by the Arbitrator on 10.11.2000. The remedy available to the petitioner was to challenge the said award by moving an application under Section 34 of the Act.

Hence, the present petition is dismissed being not maintainable.
