Since respondents No.1 and 2 after having been proceeded against ex-parte vide order dated 19.9.2014 have put in appearance through Sh. G.N. Malik, Advocate, this application has become infructuous and is dismissed as such.

Main Case

So far as respondent No.3 is concerned, since none had made appearance for her and Mr. Malik claims to be appearing only on behalf of respondents, No.1 and 2, she is proceeded against ex-parte.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of this petition with liberty to take all the pleas, as have been raised in this petition,

before the lower court at an appropriate stage but urges that some time limit should be fixed for adjudication of the petition pending before the lower court.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty. However, the lower court would decide the petition within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, even by conducting day to day proceedings, if so required.
