Vide impugned order a sum of Rs.4000/- per month has been awarded to the respondent wife under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act in proceedings for divorce initiated by the petitioner.

The amount of interim maintenance does not appear to be excessive and is the bare minimum required for survival of the respondent wife.

No ground is made out for interference in the impugned order.

Dismissed.

While dismissing this petition, it is observed that the trial Court shall make earnest endeavour to resolve the controversy by some amicable settlement by referring the matter to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre at his own level.
