This petition is directed against the order dated 12.1.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has vehemently argued that the evidence of Rakesh Kumar, alleged eye witness, is necessary in this case. It is submitted that he has come to know from some shop-keepers of the area where the accident took place that Rakesh Kumar is the eye witness of the accident.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners, I am of the considered opinion that there is no merit in this case as the reasons given by the trial Court in para No.5 of the impugned order are without any blemish.
