Counsel for the petitioner referring to the impugned orders has urged that the petition for succession certificate was dismissed under Order XVII Rule 3 CPC for non-production of evidence by the lower court on 16.12.2006.

Counsel for respondent No.2 showing benevolence has urged that one opportunity should be granted to the petitioner for conclusion of his evidence and some time frame should be fixed.

In view of this position, this petition is disposed of with a direction that the court concerned shall provide only one opportunity to the

petitioner to conclude her entire evidence and decide the matter within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, even by conducting day to day proceedings, if so required.
