This order shall dispose of aforesaid three revision petitions since  
common questions of law and facts are involved in the same.

Municipal Council Thanesar in all the above three revision petitions is aggrieved against the attachment of their bank accounts towards execution of the awards dated 14.10.2010, passed by the learned Arbitrator awarding compensation in favour of the respondents/decreed holders.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner/J.D. States that the aforesaid revisions have become infructuous since the decretal amount due to each decreed holder stands paid and the bank accounts released.
