The plaintiff has sought for permission of the Court to re-open his side to file a document, namely, a legal notice issued under Section 106 of the Transfer of Property Act, to which, a reference has been made in the plaint and to exhibit it evidence. The Court has declined the same without assigning any reason.

I do not think it is fair to deny an opportunity to the plaintiff to file the documents and to exhibit the same with appropriate oral evidence. The petitioner shall pay cost of ₹2000/- to the respondent/defendant as condition precedent for setting aside the order already passed. Payment shall be made within two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order to the contesting respondents. The interim order is set aside and the revision petition is allowed on the above terms. If the amount is not paid as directed, the order already passed will stand restored.
