Petitioner has filed this petition challenging the orders dated 28.01.2014 and 09.04.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner has filed suit for mandatory injunction. The evidence of the petitioner was closed vide order dated 28.01.2014. In fact, sister of the petitioner had died nine days prior to the date fixed before the trial Court and due to this reason, petitioner could not lead his evidence. Learned counsel has further submitted that the petitioner be granted one opportunity to enable him to lead his evidence.

In view of the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, it would be just and expedient to grant one opportunity to the petitioner to enable him to lead his evidence.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed. Trial Court is

directed to grant one effective opportunity to the petitioner to enable him to lead his evidence at his own risk and responsibility, subject to payment of ₹2,500/- as costs. Costs be deposited with the District Legal Services Authority. Thereafter, the trial Court shall proceed further with the case in accordance with law.
