Respondents had filed the petition under Section 13 of the East Punjab Urban Rent Restriction Act, 1949 seeking ejectment of the petitioner. The learned Rent Controller vide order dated 06.08.2014 allowed the ejectment petition. The said order was upheld by the Appellate Authority vide judgment dated 29.04.2015. Hence, the present petition by the petitioner-tenant.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he does not press the revision petition on merits and prayed that the petitioner be granted time to vacate the demised premises upto 31.01.2016 as it was in possession of the premises in question for a number of years.

In view of submissions made by the learned

counsel for the petitioner, this revision petition is dismissed on merits. However, the petitioner is granted time from today to vacate the demised premises, i.e. on or before 31.01.2016. This order shall operate subject to filing of an undertaking by the petitioner in this regard before the learned Rent Controller within 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and on making payment of the entire arrears of rent, if any due, within a period of four weeks from today and shall also keep on paying the rent of ensuing months upto 31.01.2016 to the respondent on or before 10th of each calendar month.
