There is no reason for the petitioner to arrive in this Court and complain that his evidence has been closed. The remedy lies in a party who is aggrieved by the side being closed to file an application before the very same Court and set out the reason for his inability to let in evidence on that day and seek for reopening and offering evidence. If such a request is made, the Court is bound to pass an order in the light of the observations and law laid down by this Court in Santosh Kumar Berry Vs. Nirmala Devi and others decided on 25.09.2012.

The civil revision petition is disposed of and the Court will have to follow the procedure as already laid down by this Court in the aforesaid judgment.
