The revision petition is by the wife complaining of inadequacy of maintenance granted by trial Court in matrimonial proceedings initiated by the husband for divorce against the wife. The amount of ₹22,000/- awarded by the trial Court is stated to be inadequate.

The respondent states that the case has already been concluded and the petition was dismissed and has preferred an appeal to this Court and the same is pending. Since the proceedings in appeal are continuation of the proceedings before the court below, a prayer for adequate maintenance could be considered at the Appellate Court on the basis of documents which are relevant for its determination. The

civil revision is therefore, disposed of as requiring no further modification but with liberty to the wife to seek modification of the maintenance already granted, during the pendency of the appeal.
