Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant revision petition with liberty to file fresh application for leave to defend due to some changed circumstances. It is further his contention that during the pendency of the instant petition, the present landlord has got the possession of some other shop in some other ejectment proceedings and as such the instant petition under Section 13-A of the Haryana Urban (Control of Rent and Eviction), 1973 is not tenable due to above-said changed circumstances

In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, he is permitted to withdraw the instant revision petition. So, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file fresh application for leave to defend, if the same is permissible as per law.
