Decree-holder Dharamvir has filed execution application against Pawan Kumar for execution of a decree for partition. The petitioner appears to be auction purchaser of the property.

Through instant application, he seeks a direction to the trial Court to decide the execution proceedings expeditiously as the Executing Court has permitted the judgment debtor to file objections.

As the petitioner is not a party to the execution application and he has allegedly purchased the property in dispute, has locus standi to seek a direction to the Executing Court where he is not a party, is apparently a debatable issue. This revision for direction to the Executing Court is hereby dismissed as not maintainable. However, the rights of the petitioner to contest his right in the capacity as an auction purchaser will not be prejudiced in any manner.
