SABINA, J

Petitioner has filed this petition challenging the order dated 14.07.2015, whereby, application moved by the petitioner to adjourn the suit sine-die, was dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that both the parties have lodged criminal cases against each other. Both the parties have been convicted by the trial Court in the criminal cases and appeals have been filed by both the parties against their conviction. Both the parties have also filed suit for recovery of damages. Learned counsel has further submitted that the suit in question was liable to be adjourned sine-die to await the decision of the criminal appeals pending in this Court.

The finding given in the criminal case will have no bearing on the civil suit as the parties are required to prove their case by leading evidence in the civil litigation. Learned trial Court had thus, rightly dismissed the application moved by the petitioner for adjourning the suit sine-die to await the decision in the criminal appeal.

Hence, no ground for interference by this Court is made out.
