Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 4.3.2015, passed by the learned court below, awarding interim maintenance to the respondent-wife in an application under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, 'the Act').

The contention sought to be raised by learned counsel for the petitioner is that once the respondent-wife was getting maintenance under Section 125 Cr.P.C., she cannot claim maintenance under Section 24 of the Act.

The contention is totally misconceived as rights available under Section 24 of the Act and 125 Cr.P.C. are independent and not mutually exclusive.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.
