SABINA, J

Petitioners have filed this petition challenging the order dated 04.07.2015.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and have gone through the record available on the file carefully.

Respondent No.1 has filed suit for specific performance of agreement to sell dated 07.01.2005. Evidence of the petitioner was closed vide order dated 05.11.2012. Petitioners approached this Court by way of Civil Revision No.6927 of 2012. The said petition was allowed and the trial Court was directed to grant one effective opportunity to the petitioners to enable them to conclude their evidence at their own risk and responsibility. However, petitioners could not conclude their evidence, although, one effective opportunity was granted to the petitioners to enable them to conclude their evidence at their own risk and responsibility.

Hence, the impugned order, whereby, no further opportunity was granted to the petitioners to enable them to lead their evidence, calls for no interference.

Dismissed.
