Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he filed a complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act against the respondents for dishonour of cheque for a sum of ₹ 44,31,805/-. Thereafter, payment of ₹ 4,00,000/- has been made and now balance is ₹ 40,31,805/-. During the pendency of the complaint, on the statement made by Arun Brar, Managing Director of the respondent-company, the matter was settled in Lok Adalat on 3.8.2013 with an undertaking that the amount shall be paid to the petitioner within six to nine months from the date of compromise. The amount having not been paid, execution was filed on 13.5.2014, which is still pending and is now fixed for 19.8.2015. The prayer is for a direction to the court below to dispose of the same on the next date of hearing.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to the court below to dispose of the execution petition filed by the petitioner on the next date of hearing fixed for 19.8.2015 or maximum by 15.9.2015.
