Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 3.7.2015, passed by the court below, whereby on an application filed by respondent No. 1 under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, maintenance of ₹ 3,000/- per month was fixed. Besides that, litigation expenses of ₹ 5,000/- were directed to be paid.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he is not challenging the order on quantum of maintenance granted. The challenge is on the ground that respondent No. 1 is living in adultery. In support, reference is sought to be made to certain panchayati compromise placed on record as Annexures P1 to P4. It is not in dispute that writings in the aforesaid compromise are yet to be proved by the petitioner by leading evidence. In the absence thereof, at the interim stage, no final opinion can be expressed as regards the conduct of respondent No. 1 merely on the basis

of panchayati compromise placed on record by the petitioner either before the court below or before this court.

In view of the above, I do not find any reason to interfere with the impugned order. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
