Challenge in this petition is to the order dated 17.07.2015 (Annexure P-12) passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Panipat, whereby evidence of the plaintiff-petitioner has been closed by order.

In the present petition, notice of motion was issued on 11.08.2015 to examine, whether summoning of Record Keeper from the office of Deputy Commissioner was necessary to prove the eviction application filed by the Gram Panchayat under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation), Act (for short 'the Act').

Learned counsel for Gram Panchayat-respondent No.1 states that the application filed by the Gram Panchayat under Section 7 of the Act, filed in the year 1991, has since been revived and the same is pending consideration for 27.08.2015.

Since pendency of the application is not being disputed by the Gram Panchayat-respondent No.1, at this stage, no ground is made out to interfere with the impugned order dated 17.07.2015 (Annexure P-12).
