SABINA, J

Petitioners have filed this petition challenging the order dated 07.07.2015, whereby, application moved by the petitioner for permission to lead additional evidence, was dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that birth certificate of Shakuntla and death certificate of Maya Devi were very necessary to be proved on record.

In the present case, respondent has filed suit for permanent injunction against the petitioners that they be restrained from dispossessing or interfering in her peaceful possession. Petitioners closed their evidence in March 2015. Thereafter, petitioners moved an application for permission to lead additional evidence in May 2015 with a view to prove on record birth certificate of Shakuntla and death certificate of Maya Devi. The death certificate of Maya Devi was obtained

by the petitioners on 09.06.2011, whereas, the birth certificate of Shakuntla was obtained by the petitioners on 07.06.2011. Thus, the documents now sought to be proved on record by way of additional evidence were already available with the petitioners, but they had failed to produce them on record while leading their evidence. In these circumstances, the learned trial Court rightly dismissed the application moved by the petitioners for permission to lead additional evidence.

No ground for interference by this Court, is made out.
