In terms of order dated 05.11.2014, an affidavit of Dr. Avtar Singh, Principal Secretary to Government of Haryana, Transport Department, has been filed in Court today, by the learned State counsel, which is taken on record.

As per the said affidavit, the claim of the petitioner for family pension was considered in the light of various judgments of this Court, as also the Supreme Court, and she has been sanctioned family pension vide order dated 09.01.2015, a copy of which has been annexed with the affidavit as Annexure R-1.

A very fair stand has been taken by the State.

This petition, is therefore, disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

The benefits, including arrears, as would be calculated in terms

of the order dated 09.01.2015, be released to the petitioner, along with interest @ 6% per annum, from the date that the family pension first accrued to her, till the actually date of payment thereof.

It shall be released within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
