This order will dispose of two petitions bearing Civil Revision Nos. 4901 and 4902 of 2015, as the same arise out of common award dated 27.4.2015, passed by Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Chandigarh (for short, 'the Tribunal').

The amount involved in both the petitions is ₹ 5,000/- each, awarded as compensation to respondent No. 1 therein.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the present petitions had to be filed to challenge the award of the Tribunal as the compensation awarded in other cases arising out of the same accident is much higher and the same has been challenged by filing FAO Nos. 4097 to 4101 and 4129 of 2015.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, in my opinion, considering the amount involved in the present petitions, the same do not deserve to be entertained. However, it is made clear that dismissal of the present petitions will not, in any way, affect the merits of the award, which has been impugned in the appeals filed by the petitioner, where the amount

of compensation awarded is much higher.

With the aforesaid observations, the present petitions are dismissed.
