During the course of hearing, a consensus emerged between the counsel for the parties that as entire arrears of rent, to date, have since been deposited by the respondent on different intervals, with the Treasury at Kurukshetra, the same be released to the petitioner forthwith. And as regards future rent, learned counsel for the respondent undertakes that the same shall be deposited by 7th of every month directly with the petitioner and an undertaking in this regard in the form of an affidavit shall be furnished with the trial Court within two weeks' from today.

That being so, counsel for the parties are ad-idem that nothing substantive survives in this petition and the same be disposed of as having become infructuous.
