Challenge in this petition is to the order dated 15.07.2015 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Hoshiarpur, whereby evidence of the claimant-petitioner has been closed by order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia*, contends that while closing the evidence of claimant-petitioner, the Tribunal has observed that four effective opportunities were given to conclude her evidence, but she has failed to produce any evidence.

As per zimni orders dated 05.01.2015 and 26.03.2015, the trial was not taken up for hearing, therefore, no effective opportunity was provided to the petitioner to lead her evidence on those dates.

In view of the above, the impugned order dated 15.07.2015 (Annexure P-4) is set aside and two effective opportunities are granted to the petitioner to conclude her evidence, subject to costs of Rs.3,000/- to be deposited with the Punjab State Legal Service Authority.

Allowed accordingly.
