M.M.S. Bedi, J.

Counsel for the petitioners along with Ramandeep Singh son of petitioner No. 2, present in Court, submits that the petitioner No. 2 has given a Special Power of Attorney to Ramandeep Singh. Counsel submits that he has got instructions to state that the petitioners will vacate the premises in dispute by 31.08.2015. Counsel for the respondents has submitted that in case the premises is vacated by 31.08.2015, he has got instructions to state that the petitioners will be exempted from paying the mesne profits.

In view of the undertaking given on behalf of the petitioners to vacate the premises by 31.08.2015, this petition is disposed of as having rendered infructuous.

It is made clear that in case of violation of the undertaking by the petitioners, it would be open for the respondents to approach this Court for any appropriate legal remedy.
