Impugned in the present revision petition is the order dated 06.07.2015 (Annexure P-5) passed by learned Addl. District Judge, Chandigarh, vide which the time for depositing of court fee was extended up to 28.07.2015.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, I am of the view that the impugned order does not call for any interference. It is the discretion of the lower court to extend the time for payment of court fee.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, which according to the lower court appeared to be genuine, the time was extended. Secondly, the extended time has already been expired and there is nothing on file to show that the court fee has not been deposited.

Accordingly, the present revision petition stands dismissed.
