Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral)

In compliance to the order dated 18.8.2015, learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on file copies of the interim orders. The same are taken on record.

It comes out that after granting three opportunities, one last opportunity was granted. On the 4th opportunity, the plaintiff failed to conclude his evidence and the same was closed by order vide order dated 14.5.2015.

The request of learned counsel for the petitioner is that he may be granted one more opportunity to conclude his evidence at his own risk and responsibility subject to costs. The suit is for recovery of more than Rs.22 lacs with interest on account of damages.

Keeping in view the nature of the suit and the request of

the learned counsel for the petitioner, the revision is disposed of without issuing notice to the opposite party. The present revisionist is given one more opportunity to conclude his evidence subject to payment of costs of Rs.5000/- to be deposited in District Legal Aid Fund, Fatehgarh Sahib. The plaintiff shall produce his entire evidence at his own risk and responsibility. He can obtain the summons of witnesses dasti but Court will not compel the appearance of any witness.

Revision is accordingly allowed.
