Learned counsel for the respondent points out that pursuant to the order dated May 13, 2015, the petitioner/tenant was required to deposit entire arrears of mesne profits @ ₹10,000/- per month from November 2002 within a period of two months from the date of the order. However, the order has not been complied with as the requisite amount has since not been deposited. Not just that, nobody has caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner either to pursue the matter.

That being so, the Court is choice-less but to dismiss the petition for non-prosecution.

Ordered accordingly.
