This petition has been filed to challenge the order dated 23.03.2013 passed by Punjab Wakf Board Tribunal, Bathinda, decreeing 6suit of the wakf board.

The only argument raised by learned counsel for the petitioner is that the suit was bad for non joinder of necessary parties because according to the petitioner, the property in dispute was in possession of Sant Kaur, who sold it to the petitioner and who further sold it to Gulzar Singh. However, it is fairly conceded that no evidence in this regard has been produced. As issue No. 3 and 4 have been decided by the trial court on the ground that the defendant has failed to lead evidence.

In view of the above, I do not find any merit in the case.  
Therefore, the revision petition is hereby dismissed.
