Present revision has been preferred against the judgment dated 2.5.2003, passed by Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sonapat, whereby accused was acquitted of charge under sections 279/304-A IPC.

Prosecution produced eye witness namely, Ram Kalan. He deposed as PW1, but did not support the prosecution story. ASI Ram Parkash who deposed as PW2, only deposed regarding the mechanical examination of the tractor in question. Other formal witnesses also deposed. However, nothing came on record to establish the guilt of the accused. As a result, trial court acquitted the accused.

I find no infirmity with the judgment passed by the court below. Besides, it appears State has not preferred any appeal against the judgment delivered by the trial court.

No merits. Dismissed.
