K.Kannan, J. (Oral)

1. Revision has no meaning in a situation where plaintiff has not affixed court fee for setting aside the relief and thanks to the intervention by this court through the interim order, the issue of court fee was directed not to be taken up and proceed with the trial. Strange, as it would seem, the fact is that the suit has also been disposed of and the appeal is reported to have been filed by the plaintiff.

2. The issue of necessary court fee payable will be considered by the court and pass appropriate orders and if the

plaintiff is successful, the decree will not be drawn up till the court fee is paid. The issue of requisite court fee will be decided at or before the disposal of the appeal before the appellate court.

3. The revision petition is disposed of with the above observations.
