1. The learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the revision petition, in view of the fact that the matrimonial proceedings itself have concluded.

3. The wife shall be entitled to secure the interim maintenance awarded at the particular rate by the court below till the date of disposal of the petition and would also be competent to pray for recovery of Rs. 20,000/- already awarded by this court on 11.8.2014 in accordance with law.
4. The revision petition is dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
