On April 7, 2015, this court had passed the following order:

“Notices could not be issued to the unserved respondents for want of correct addresses.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will do the needful forthwith.

Let, notices be issued to the unserved respondents on furnishing their correct addresses for 24.09.2015.”

Office report shows that notices could not be issued to respondents No.1, 2, 6, 7 to 11, 14, 15 & 21, as their correct addresses were not furnished by the counsel for the petitioner. Nor the necessary application was moved to bring on record the LRs of respondents No.3 & 4.

Nobody is present either to pursue the matter on behalf of the petitioner. That being so, the court is choice-less but to dismiss the petition for non-prosecution.

Ordered, accordingly.
